



Niagara 9200 Quick Start

The Niagara 9200 is an embedded Windows appliance so the desktop is not exposed to the user. If needed it can be accessed by contacting support@niagara-video.com. Normally all operations can be accessed via a web browser. All popular browsers are supported. (IE, Firefox, Chrome and Safari)

Plug in both power cords or you will get an annoying beeping alarm. Connect network cables to the appropriate physical ports, see below. You can connect the video cables before or after start up.

The 9200 can be configured with a variety of network modules. The 4 port Ethernet module is the default one with the base model. One option is to add a 2 port Ethernet module. In this case the management port is Adapter_6, not Adapter_4.

The management port (Adapter_4 in the web GUI) is configured with DHCP. See figure below. Adapters 0 and 1 are used for local testing so these will have our internal static configurations. You are free to change these, of course. Adapters 2 and 3 have static IP addresses of 192.168.1.2 and 192.168.1.3 respectively. You can access the system with any of the ports.



Once everything is connected start up the system with the power button located next to the power cables. The system may start up when you connect the power cables, this is normal the first time you connect the cables.
